EMPLOYMENT OUTLOOK

Counselors and psychologists hold about 650,000 jobs. Through the year 2010, overall employment of counselors is expected to grow faster than the average for all occupations, while employment of psychologists is expected to grow about as fast as the average for all psychologists' occupations. Numerous job openings will occur as many counselors reach retirement age. More than four out of ten psychologists are self-employed. The median annual wage of salaried psychologists is \$48,596, while the median annual wage for counselors ranges from \$24,450 to \$42,110.
